

Troop 526 Peek'n Peak Ski Trip & Camping
Jan 11, 12 2008



Parents: This is a combination camping trip and ski trip for the scouts that are capable skiers or snowboarders. A separate weekend event is being planned for the non-skiing scouts.

Scouts must be able to ski/snowboard on their own, and capable of getting on and off the chair lifts at Peek'n Peak ski resort without requiring assistance. Although there will be adults skiing and in the chalet, it will not be possible to stay together as a group. As such, I plan to have each youth wear some soft of bandana around one arm so that they can identify each other better, and to require one or two check-ins during the day where they must come inside to check in with an adult.

- Trip size limited to 20 including adults.
- We will not be cooking on this trip, but eating out for lunch and dinner
- We will be camping at camp Merz located at 5273 West Lake Rd. Mayville, NY 14757. Phone 716-753-7194 . Cabin is heated only by a wood burning stove
- We will meet at the scout building on Jan. 11th at 5:30pm and leaving by 6:00 pm. Driving time is 3.5 hrs assuming good weather.
- **Approximate trip costs are \$69 without ski or snowboard rental equipment.** This assumes we have a minimum of 15 that will purchase lift tickets so that we qualify for group rates. If we do not, the price will be about \$10 higher.
- Ski rental fee is \$19/day, snowboard \$24/day.

Breakfast will be provided on Saturday morning and snack for Friday night
Scouts bring their own money for Saturday lunch and dinner
All scouts assets \$10 for gas & \$5 for snack & breakfast food
We need at least 4-5 adult drivers

Total cost for scout with own equipment: \$34 (lift ticket)+\$15(gas & food)+\$20(own meals)=\$69
Total cost for scout without equipment: \$34(lift ticket) +\$24(snowboard)+\$15(gas & food)+\$20(own meals)=\$93

Total cost for an adult without equipment: \$34+\$19(skis)+\$5(food)+\$20(own meals)= \$78

We leave Peek and Peak around 5-6PM, stop for dinner on the way back, get back to St Albert's around 9-10PM
